The Directors now have a 3-year plan to eventually to become a major player in the supply and delivery of pallets in West London & SE England. Tasks include:

- Strengthening business relationships with Borough Councils and Chambers of Commerce including but not limited to Ealing, Hounslow, Brentford, Hillingdon, Park Royal, Hertfordshire and Buckinghamshire
- Forging new relationships with distribution and logistics companies operating in and around Heathrow Airport, and with the airport itself when it fully reopens
- Forming partnerships with large warehousing operators such as Amazon and Costco
- Boosting the company's pallet intake by over 5,000 pallets per week
- Raising its local business profile within the West London business community
- Utilising lead generation services offered by LinkedIn and Twitter
